Nuno Felting for Weavers

WORKSHOP DESCRIPTION

AKA Weaving for Nuno Felters. It seems like everyone has discovered the fabulous textures that can be created by laminating wool fibers to cloth. Now you can combine weaving and felting in a great new process. We will begin by weaving a loose web of cloth, take it off the loom, add luxurious merino wool fibers and then wet felt everything together. Beginners to advanced in either technique will love this combination.

EXPERIENCE LEVEL: All; must be able to wind a warp independently

MATERIAL FEE: \$35 to \$40

STUDENT SUPPLY LIST

- Loom or rigid heddle loom
- Pre-wound warp (instructions sent of ahead class)
- scissors
- bubble wrap 15" x 3 yards
- towel
- half length pool noodle
- stocking legs or elastic for ties
- small plastic container (about 6 cup size)
- note taking supplies.

INCLUDED IN MATERIAL FEE

- wool fiber
- some yarns
- all misc. supplies
